Coligone has been designed specifically to maintain acid levels in horses, guard against gastric irritation and promote a healthy digestive system.

All kinds of horses experience stress in some form or another due to the various pressures enforced upon them. Competition horses and race horses are particularly at risk, having extensive travel and training schedules, long periods spent without food, high starch diets and limited turnout, which can all have an effect on the balance of the digestive tract.

Coligone is FREE of ANY BANNED SUBSTANCES and can be used whilst competing under FEI and Jockey Club rules

Disturbance of the microflora within the digestive tract and raised acid levels can have a severe knock on effect on horse's temperaments and way of going, which means, especially in competition horses, it is vital for the acid levels to remain balanced. A daily supplement of Coligone can assist with the fight against acid build up, signs of which may be a gassy, bloated tummy, tucked up appearance, cribbing or wind sucking or poor performance.

Administered orally Coligone helps maintain healthy acid levels and supports the digestive system. Research has suggested that gastric acid related problems in horses are caused by the prolonged exposure of the squamous mucosal lining to gastric acid (The upper half of the horse's stomach has a lining of squamous epithelial cells, which are similar to the lining of the oesophagus. This part of the stomach doesn't have the protective mucous layer, like the lower parts of the stomach, therefore gastric acid erosion in the upper part of the stomach appears to be similar to heartburn in humans. Squamous mucosa does not have a mucous layer and therefore doesn't secrete bicarbonate onto its surface like the glandular portion of the stomach. The only protection from gastric acid and pepsin comes from saliva production and if the horse isn't producing enough saliva to buffer the gastric acid and coat the surface of the stomach, then gastric irritation can occur.

The following can cause stress and may therefore have a negative effect on the digestive system:

- Competing/Racing.
- Travelling (spending long periods of time without food)
- Sugar/starch intolerance
- Too much time spent gorging on fresh grass
- High grain diets and limited turnout.
- Foals with stress and high gastric acid levels at weaning.
- Sick horses or those having undergone surgery.

It has been reported that up to 60% of foals have gastric acid related issues from birth, which can result in foals experiencing side effects such as teeth grinding, salivating, crib biting, wind sucking, inability to hold weight, stomach upsets and cramps.

Feeding Coligone, which maintains natural acid balance within the digestive tract, may assist in such circumstances. Coligone liquid is designed to soothe the digestive tract, balance acid levels and maintain a healthy environment which enables the foal to thrive. Coligone's unique action coats the stomach and provides a buffer-raft, to protect the delicate upper areas of the stomach from excessive gastric acid. Used on a daily basis or when required, Coligone is gentle on the foal's digestive system and yet extremely effective.

Periods such as weaning are instances when both mare and foal encounter stress. Feeding Coligone Powder may help to prevent digestive disturbances at this time. The bioavailability of minerals in Coligone Powder, particularly calcium, supports bone development and strength and is also useful for lactating mares to support milk production. The balance of microflora within the foal's gut can easily be unbalanced by stress, which can result in scouring and invasion by bad bacteria. Prebiotics and Yea sacc are two excellent ingredients which support the hind gut and both are designed to encourage good bacteria to flourish and improve feed (protein) utilisation. (Undesirable bacteria in the foal's digestive tract can lead to it being unable to thrive.) Research has shown that live yeast supplementation can improve lactation in mares and the broad-spectrum mineral availability in Coligone Powder not only boosts digestive health but also bone strength, hoof and coat condition and general well-being in both mare and foal.

Coligone can be administered during times of stress & also prior to travelling or competing and is suitable for foals and horses. Administering Coligone Liquid on first signs of discomfort can combat bloated, gassy or tucked up tummies which can be associated with stress. Can be fed adhoc or on a daily basis (50ml twice a day) to support the digestive tract and aid the stomach against gastric acid. Helps to maintain healthy acid levels in the gut and may be used during periods where disturbance of the microflora has occurred within the digestive tract. Administering Coligone Oral Syringes can combat bloated, gassy or tucked up tummies, which can be associated with stress. The Seaweed Buffer and Sodium Bicarbonate soothe and coat the stomach, buffering excess acid. Sodium bicarbonate also reacts with the acid in the stomach to form bubbles of carbon dioxide and disperse gases built up within the digestive tract.
